



By investing in downspout extensions, you can direct water away from your property, so it doesn't linger and cause damage to the foundation. A good rule of thumb is to include downspouts which extend at least three feet away from your foundation.

## 2 Double check your exterior plumbing.

Winter can sneak up on us all. First we're enjoying the fall and the next thing you know, the new year is here!

So it's best to double check that you've turned off all of your outside faucets, removed and drained hoses and shut off the water valves to the outside.


## 3 Don't wait until your roof is leaking to call a professional.

There's no way to know if shingles have been lost, gutters have been clogged by late autumn leaves or wear has developed. ## 4 Check that Chimney

Chimney, particularly those attached to a fireplace, require annual inspections. The outdoor area of the chimney can become damaged or cracked, while chimney caps can become loose, making it vulnerable to blockages.



## 5 Look for Heat Leaks

We all know drafts can cause major heat loss in the winter, which can waste money and energy. Doors and windows are the biggest culprit of course, so it's important not to ignore these spaces when you're winterizing. To begin, make sure to check for any cracks or breaks in your window and door frames. In terms of windows, don't overlook easy steps to winterize, such as making sure you have storm windows in place, have caulked gaps and added weather stripping where needed. Doors can get a similarly practical winterizing approach. First, always use your exterior doors' deadbolts. This seems like a minor action, but it dramatically helps to lock your doors into place. Next consider adding in weather-stripping or aluminum gaskets to doors. And finally, for outdated windows and doors, consider investing in new, high efficiency options which require little maintenance and help to lock in heat and remove those annoying drafty spots from the home.

## 6 Shield Your Siding from Damage

Siding can look impervious to the elements, but there are some important winterizing steps to take to keep it looking its best. It's a good idea to inspect for cracks and weak spots as freezing moisture can cause the smallest imperfections to expand into major problems.
